Askham Bryan College equestrian department offers training courses suitable for those working in the equine industry, who wish to continue their qualifications. In 2010 the college is offering further training for all those wishing to progress in British Horse Society qualifications beyond the BHS Assistant Instructors qualification.

The courses are specifically designed for those people wishing to take BHS exams, however, they may also be useful for the competition rider or stable manager who wish to improve their knowledge and skills for their current role in the industry.

All the courses involve practical activity – either riding, teaching or stable management depending on the course. If candidates wish to take the exam in the near future, they will be given guidance and advice from an examiners point of view to enable them to fully prepare for the exam. These courses are also suitable for those wishing to assess whether they wish to take the exam in the longer term future.

The following courses will be presented by Patrick Print FBHS. Patrick is chairman of the BHS and is a chief examiner for all levels of BHS exams including the Fellowship and BHSI exams. An internal Askham Bryan College BHSI will also support in the delivering of all the BHSII level courses.

All the courses are run in association with Harper Adams University College and Reednet funding, so on completion of each two day course there will be a short assessment to complete and successful candidates will be awarded a module that can be used towards other higher education qualifications.
