

HELP WITH TRAVEL COSTS

If you are studying a further education course and aged between 16-19, you may be eligible for a grant towards your transport costs, depending on your circumstances. We strongly recommend that students contact their Local Authority to see if they are eligible for help with transport costs.

East Riding Council (residents of East Yorkshire)

East Riding offers 20%, 40% or 70% of travel costs, students/parent are expected to pay the remainder. In order to qualify for assistance you must live more than three miles from the College and meet the necessary financial requirements.

City of York Council (for residents of York)

The City of York Council offers a free daily pass for travel to and from College. In order to qualify for assistance you must live more than three miles from the College, and you have to be attending the nearest institution offering your chosen course of study, your parent (s) must be in receipt of certain benefits or have an income below £15,000.

North Yorkshire County Council (for residents of North Yorkshire)

North Yorkshire County Council offers a transport grant/subsidised fares for students studying at the College. Students/parents are required to pay the first £325 towards their travel costs and North Yorkshire will subsidise the rest. In order to qualify for this grant students must live at least 3 miles from the College and it has to be the nearest institution offering the course of study and be within reasonable daily travelling distance.

Leeds City Council

Leeds City Council offers £210 towards travel outside West Yorkshire (£70 reimbursed at the end of each term) you are required to pay the remainder. In order to qualify for this you must live at least three miles from the College, and it has to be the nearest institution offering the course of study and be within reasonable daily travelling distance.
