



## **BSc (Hons) Animal Conservation (Top Up)**

UCAS Code: C3T4

The BSc/BSc (Hons) Animal Conservation (top-up) programme has been designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills to enter careers related to the conservation of animals.

Areas relating to recent advances, the sustainability of the industry and environmental change are incorporated. Students will study a range of animal wildlife, developing survey and management skills and understand how conservation projects and organisations are managed.

Knowledge of business principles and management skills is developed, allowing students work effectively at management level within a company.

This course has an emphasis on

conservation projects and how animal conservation organisations are funded together with a critical review of the recent advances associated with the conservation of species.

### ASSESSMENT

Assessments will be designed to give students the opportunity of performing tasks that they would be asked to do in employment. There are a range of assessment methods used, including reports, case studies, presentations, viva voce, continual assessments and exams. Typically each module involves two assessments.

### IN COURSE COSTS

Students will be required to have PPE in the form of overalls, steel toe boots and a white lab coat before starting the course. Also students are typically provided with the opportunity to take part in international study tours to a variety of locations. Previous study tours run by the University Centre include South Africa, Peru, Tenerife, Italy, Paris, London and Scotland.

### AFTER THE COURSE

Students studying the course may

enter a wide variety of roles in the industry, working in wildlife ecology, zoo management, education, conservation and environmental health related areas. Students may also progress to higher level study such as Masters or PhD.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To study the BSc (Hons) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Merit or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

To study the BSc (Ord) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Pass or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

Applicants who believe they may be eligible for Accreditation of Prior Certificated and/or Experiential Learning (APCL/APEL) will be considered on an individual basis. If you have any queries in relation to entry qualifications, then please contact the University Centre directly.
