



## **BSc (Hons) Zoo Management (Top Up)**

UCAS Code: D303

The BSc/BSc (Hons) Zoo Management (Top-Up) programme has been designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills to enter the zoological collections industry. Areas relating to recent advances, the husbandry of captive animals, economic factors affecting the sustainability of the industry and environmental change are incorporated.

Students will study the management of collections in terms of visitors, animals and infrastructure such as enclosure design. Knowledge of business principles and management skills is also developed, allowing students to work

effectively at management level within a company.

### ASSESSMENT

Assessments will be designed to give students the opportunity of performing tasks that they would be asked to do in employment. There are a range of assessment methods used, including reports, case studies, presentations, viva voce, continual assessments and exams. Typically each module involves two assessments.

### IN COURSE COSTS

Students will be required to have PPE in the form of overalls and steel toe boots before starting the course.

Also students are typically provided with the opportunity to take part in international study tours to a variety of locations. Previous study tours run by the University Centre include South Africa, Peru, Tenerife, Italy, Paris, London and Scotland.

### AFTER THE COURSE

Students studying the course may enter a wide variety of roles in the industry.

Working in Zoo Management, education, conservation, charitable organisations and in research related areas. Students may also progress to higher level study such as Masters or PhD.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To study the BSc (Hons) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Merit or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

To study the BSc (Ord) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Pass or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

Applicants who believe they may be eligible for Accreditation of Prior Certificated and/or Experiential Learning (APCL/APEL) will be considered on an individual basis. If you have any queries in relation to entry qualifications, then please contact the University Centre directly.
