



BSc (Hons) Equine Science & Management (Top-Up)

UCAS Code: D464

The BSc/BSc (Hons) Equine Science & Management (top-up) programme has been designed to equip students with the knowledge and skills to enter the equine related industry.

This programme integrates knowledge and skills that can be applied to a wide range of areas within the equine industry. On this programme there is an emphasis on science. The equine industry continues to develop and therefore the need for employees with appropriate technical knowledge and skills continues to evolve.

The programme will provide students with the opportunity to develop the specific knowledge, practical and technical skills fundamental to working in the equine industry. The key scientific and business management principles will be engaged

This one-year course will give students the opportunity to apply existing skills

and newly-learned knowledge to a variety of industry relevant situations, thereby preparing for work and more advanced study. As part of the honours pathway students will be required to undertake a dissertation by research, giving you an opportunity to focus for a prolonged period of time on a subject of particular interest.

Extra Curricular Activity for degree students commonly includes the BUCS HE Riding Team, Riding Academies with Chris Bartle and optional BHS Stages.

MODULES

Year 1 (Level 6) Core Modules include:

- Dissertation
- Business Leadership and Management
- Research Methods
- Applied Sustainable Practices
- Recent Advances in the Equestrian Industry
- Advanced Behaviour and Psychology



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Elective modules, students would elect one of the following,

- Advanced Nutrition
- Advanced Coaching

ASSESSMENT

Assessments will be designed to give students the opportunity of performing tasks that they would be asked to do in employment. There are a range of assessment methods used, including reports, case studies, presentations, Viva -Voce, continual assessments and exams. Typically each module involves two assessments.

IN COURSE COSTS

Students are typically provided with the opportunity to take part in international study tours to a variety of locations. PPE is also required for the behavior and nutrition modules. Ask your course tutor for more details.

AFTER THE COURSE

Students studying the course may enter a wide variety of roles in the industry as scientific research, nutrition, medical

technology and diagnostics, behavioural welfare and ethical spheres amongst others. Many students progress to higher level study.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To study the BSc (Hons) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Merit or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

To study the BSc (Ord) Top Up, applicants are required to have a Pass or above in a Foundation Degree (FdSc) or an HND in an appropriate subject.

We welcome external applications with advanced standing and accreditation of prior learning (APEL) which will be discussed upon application.

Applicants who believe they may be eligible for Accreditation of Prior Certificated and/or Experiential Learning (APCL/APEL) will be considered on an individual basis. If you have any queries in relation to entry qualifications, then please contact the University Centre directly.
