

R B MASSEY MEMORIAL TRUST

SUMMARY OF REGULATIONS GOVERNING AWARDS

1. The R B Massey Memorial Trust Fund was established "for the general benefit of the inhabitants of the town of Market Weighton and its neighbourhood for which provision is not made from public rates and taxes
2. To be eligible for a bursary, a candidate must:-
 - 2.1 reside in the Market Weighton area which means: Market Weighton and the approximate area bounded by and including Hayton, Everingham, Holme on Spalding Moor, North and South Cliffe, North Newbald, Kiplingcotes and Londesborough.
 - 2.2 furnish the Trustees with such information as they may require, and agree to permit the Trustees to verify it in any reasonable manner they wish;
 - 2.3 furnish the Trustees with such testimonials and other information as they may require.
3. **THE TRUSTEES HAVE ABSOLUTE DISCRETION TO DECIDE ON THE SUITABILITY OF AN APPLICANT FOR A BURSARY.**
4. The trust offers bursaries for Higher Education courses in the fields of horticulture, agriculture, engineering, veterinary science and technology.

The bursaries will pay towards tuition fees and residential charges not met out of public rates and taxes.
5. The bursaries are paid per term, and can continue for up to the duration of the Higher Education course.
6. 6.1 Application forms are available from the Trustees of the R B Massey Memorial Trust, c/o Stamp Jackson & Procter LLP, 5 Parliament Street, Hull, HU1 2AZ (Ref: ACP/AJE). Applications will only be considered:
 - 6.1.1 **on the prescribed current forms. THE TRUSTEES WILL ONLY CONSIDER APPLICATION FORMS WHICH ARE FULLY COMPLETED AND SUPPORTED BY RELEVANT REQUIRED INFORMATION AND REFERENCES. INCOMPLETE FORMS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED AND NO FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERED INTO;**
 - 6.1.2 accompanied by appropriate references
- 6.2 The Trustees generally consider applications in the last quarter of the year and it is therefore advisable to submit applications by the end of November for payments requested for the following year.

7. **PLEASE NOTE**

7.1 The residential requirement in paragraph 2.1 above relates to the applicant's permanent (ie: home) address.

7.2 Any grant made will be paid by cheque in the name of the Applicant. Applicants **must therefore have their own bank account.**

7.3 "Higher Education" means:-

7.3.1.1 A course for the further training of teachers or youth and community workers;

7.3.1.2 A post-graduate course (including a higher degree course);

7.3.1.3 A first degree course;

7.3.1.4 A course for the Diploma of Higher Education;

7.3.1.5 A course for the Higher National Diploma or Higher National Certificate of the Business & Technician Education Council, or the Diploma in Management Studies;

7.3.1.6 A course for the Certificate in Education;

7.3.1.7 A course in preparation for a professional examination at higher level;

7.3.1.8 A course providing education at a higher level (whether or not in preparation for an examination).

7.3.2 For the purposes of paragraph 7.3.1.7 above a professional examination is at higher level if its standard is higher than the standard of examinations at advanced level for the General Certificate of Education or the examination for the National Certificate or the National Diploma of the Business & Technician Education Council.

7.3.3 For the purposes of paragraph 7.3.1.8 above a course is to be regarded as providing education at a higher level if its standard is higher than the standard of courses providing education in preparation for any of the examinations mentioned in paragraph 7.3.2 above.
