TRANSPORT GUIDE

COVID

Please note that should the take up for transport be strong, social distancing will not be possible in all cases. We will, however, be asking anyone who has any of the recognised COVID-19 symptoms to stay at home, do not travel to college and isolate themselves. Drivers of our vehicles will not let you board if they recognise any of the symptoms.

When getting the bus to college

- Please adhere to social distancing whilst waiting for the bus
- Remember to bring your own face covering, the bus drivers will not be able to supply one for you
- If you are not wearing a face covering you will not be allowed to board the bus (unless you can prove exemption)
- Hand sanitiser will be available upon boarding and leaving the bus, which we strongly recommend using
- When you get on the bus, you must fill up the seats from the back row first
- When you arrive at your destination, the driver will tell you when you can disembark. For your own safety and for the safety of others, please follow the directions given by the driver
- When getting off the bus, you will be leaving from the front row first
- Once on site please walk on the left of all paths, follow signage and maintain social distancing

When returning home on the bus

- If you need to queue for your bus, don't forget to social distance
- Please ensure that you are wearing your face covering before you board the bus
- If you start displaying symptoms of COVID-19 whilst on campus, you will be removed from the classroom and will not be able to use college transport to get home. In this instance, parents or carers will have to make arrangements to collect you from the campus

We offer transport to and from College if you are a student enrolled on one of our courses.

We have a bus route that operates around Billingham and Stockton and the Hemlington area of Middlesbrough. We also have a minibus that picks up along the coastal route of East Cleveland starting from Whitby. Both routes operate return journeys that follow the routes of the inward journeys. This information relates to the current academic year 2019/20 only, routes may be subject to change.

In addition we provide Arriva bus passes that allows students to travel to and from college from Monday to Friday during the academic year for those students in the Teesside and East Cleveland zones.* Dependent on circumstances this can be extended to other areas such as Darlington or Peterlee.

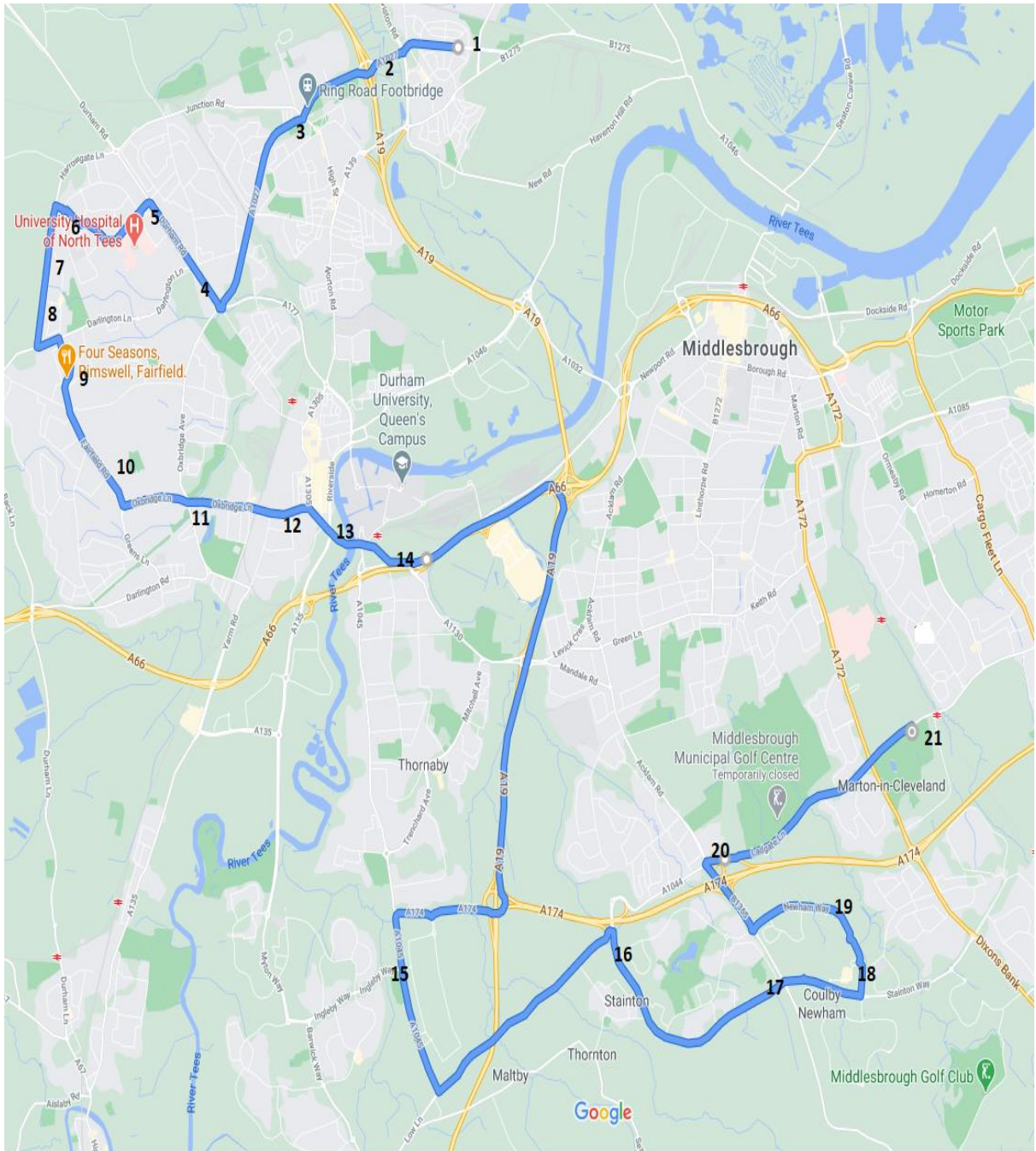


*Note that travel will be restricted to these zones. Anyone who travels outside these zones, to access Work placements for example, will not be able to use their student pass.
